FOR3008H – Capstone Project in Forest Conservation

Course Description: This course will involve analysing information and preparing formal reports based on the summer internship, in consultation with individual faculty supervisors. Students will deliver brief seminar presentations on their work, and there will be an oral defence of the final paper.

Brief description of duties: Prepare and deliver lectures, organize guest speakers, maintain course notes and readings, organize and lead a field trip, set and mark course assignments, which may include mid-term, essay and final examination or other assignments, with the support of a TA; compile, record and submit final marks. Be available to students through regular office hours.
