**Course Instructor – Spring Position 2018**

**FOR3010H – Society and Forest Conservation**

**Course Description:** The course focuses on social and political dimensions of human-forest interactions and theoretical approaches to study these interactions. It explores the social practices, institutions and regimes of power and knowledge in shaping human-forest relations. Taking a political ecology approach, the course examines how power, knowledge, culture and nature intersect and shape each other; and explore issues of equity and justice in different forest governance contexts. The course explores forest governance challenges in different parts of the world, including in Canada. The course will be run as a seminar, with student-led activities, research and presentations.

**Estimate of the course enrolment:** Approximately 30-40 graduate students

**Brief description of duties:** Prepare and deliver lectures, organize guest speakers, maintain course notes and readings, organize and lead a field trip, set and mark course assignments, which may include mid-term, essay and final examination or other assignments, with the support of a TA; compile, record and submit final marks. Be available to students through regular office hours.
