**Course Instructor – Summer Position 2018**

**FOR3011H(Y) – International Forest Conservation Field Camp**

Course Description: An intensive two-week field course based at international field stations will take place at the beginning of the summer term following the first academic session of the MFC program. The application of theoretical principles acquired in academic core courses to practical projects in community forestry and forest conservation. The course will involve students in group research and assessment, and will include cooperation with local training and research institutes, conservation projects and non-government organizations. A number of international course locations will be used.

**Sessional dates of appointment:** April 25, 2018- May 11, 2018 (Actual course dates within this time period to be determined by instructor) Please note this position includes the planning of trip prior to start date and of any course work and grading not completed by May 31, 2018

**Salary:** \$7,359.07 (vacation pay included)

**Qualifications:** Preferably a Ph.D. degree or extensive experience in forest conservation; teaching experience an asset.

**Brief description of duties:** Prepare and deliver lectures, organize guest speakers, maintain course notes and readings on Blackboard, organize and lead a field trip, set and mark course assignments, which may include mid-term, essay and final examination or other assignment, with the support of TA; compile, record and submit final marks. Be available to students through via email prior to the formal course start, and daily during the intensive two weeks in the field.
